1. JURISDICTION

This event is a National Rally, promoted by The Pukekohe Car Club and will take place on Saturday 22 August in the Waikato, Otorohanga, and Waitomo areas.

The Rally will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Three, Schedule R being the Standing Regulations for all Rallies and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

3. ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY

Your entry in the METALMAN POSSUM BOURNE MEMORIAL RALLY on 22 August 2009, promoted by the Pukekohe Car Club Inc has been accepted, subject to full completion of documentation and scrutineering.

4. RECONNAISSANCE

Before starting reconnaissance competitors are required to register either at Documentation on Tuesday 18 August or at the start of SS 1 & 5 on Friday 21 August between 1015 and 1045 hrs.

To register competitors must supply the Organisers with full details of the reconnaissance car using the Team Contact Information form included with this acceptance of entry.

Competitors are reminded that roads are not closed during reconnaissance and normal road rules apply.

It will take approximately 30 minutes to travel from Frankton, Hamilton to the start of reconnaissance.

Fuel and lunch will be available at the Oparau Roadhouse before the start of SS4 Waitomo.

5. TIMECARD

The new WRC style of timecard will be used. A sample is attached.

6. SCRUTINEERING

During the documentation process you will be advised whether your vehicle is to be subjected to audit. You should assume that your vehicle is going to be subjected to audit and as a consequence is in readiness to be taken to the audit venue immediately after you have concluded documentation.

7. TYRES

All Ford Fiesta Sporting Trophy Cars entered in Class N3 are restricted to a total of six new tyres and two used tyres that have been previously marked. Tyres will be marked at scrutineering which all Ford Fiesta Sporting Trophy Cars are required to attend. The only tyres permitted for use by Ford Fiesta Sporting Trophy Cars are Dunlop Gravel tyre – 185 / 65 R15 – 89Q – DZ86 – R – J61.

8. SERVICING AND REFUELLING

Servicing – two service vehicles are required and two Service Vehicle plates will be issued. One based at Raglan Airfield and one at the Oparau Roadhouse. These locations are shown on the Rally Map. At the Oparau Roadhouse because of space limitations there will only be space for a single car or small van per competitor.

Refuelling – competitors may refuel anywhere along the route, pump fuel is available at Raglan township (BP) and Oparau Roadhouse (Mobil).

All competitors are reminded of their responsibilities under the MotorSport New Zealand Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel.

Refuel and Service Time – There is no specific time allocated. It is an estimate only. Various Target Times will include an allowance for refuel and service. The Target Time is your report time at either TC2 or the various Regroup In Controls.

9. WITHDRAWALS & REJOINING

Competitors who have handed in a temporary withdrawal form or have phoned a temporary withdrawal to Rally Headquarters, have the opportunity to rejoin the rally after the 2nd service at Raglan. Competitors wishing to rejoin must advise the CRO before their scheduled report time to TC5A.

If the vehicle has been damaged the competitor needs to gain clearance to rejoin from the Chief Scrutineer.

Rejoining competitors will be reseeded at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

10. RECOVERIES

The Hamilton Cosmopolitan 4WD club will be following the event and offering recovery services.

11. PRIZEGIVING AND AFTER EVENT FUNCTION

The event prizegiving and after event function will be at the Pavilion of the Hamilton Workingmen's Club, 45 Commerce St, Frankton, Hamilton, dinner will be served from 1800hrs with prizegiving commencing at approx 1900hrs. A cash bar will be open at The Pavilion from 1700hrs on Saturday 22 August. The buffet roast dinner will cost \$25 per head and tickets will be available for purchase at documentation only. Tickets will **not** be available for purchase on the night.

12. PARKING AT HAMILTON WORKINGMEN'S CLUB

Parking is not permitted on the Hamilton Workingmen's Club site. Competing cars will be allowed to access the start for the Ceremonial Start and Finish under the instructions of officials. The Hamilton Workingmen's Club will be operating a pickup and drop off service within Hamilton for \$4.00 per person each way. Further details of this service will be available at documentation.
